

CULTC Safety Role 2022-23

The role of Safety Officer is one that is shared out as much as is practicable and effective within the club committee, to avoid a single point of failure and overloading individuals and to ensure appropriate input from individuals. Upholding a culture that supports the safety policy is the responsibility of all its members, as we ask them to:

- Take reasonable care for their own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by what they do or not do.
- Co-operate with the club on health and safety issues.
- Correctly use all equipment provided by the club.
- Not interfere with or misuse anything provided for their health, safety or welfare.
- Only use facilities when it is safe to do so. Particularly, do not play when courts are wet or slippery.

That being said, a number of committee positions involve specific safety responsibilities as stated in the CULTC Safety Policy. These are:

Aisha Brown and Jack Wilson-Smith, Presidents	Enforce and communicate any health and safety regulations regarding COVID-19
Robert Paraoan, Welfare Officer	Clear communication with club members on safety mattersEffective continuous management of safety arrangementsProvide appropriate mitigation control measures for injuries
Victor Baycroft, Kit secretary	Ensure that Equipment is safe
